KENT SUPPORTED INTERNSHIP

LOOKING TO ACHIEVE YOUR GOALS AND SECURE THE CAREER YOU WANT? CATCH22 AND KENT SUPPORTED EMPLOYMENT CAN HELP YOU. WE WILL GUIDE YOU THROUGH A SUPPORTED INTERNSHIP WHERE WE CAN HELP YOU TO DEVELOP THE SKILLS YOU NEED TO SECURE EMPLOYMENT.

WHAT IS A SUPPORTED INTERNSHIP?

A Supported Internship is a specialist supported employment service for people with disabilities and/or learning disabilities. They are intended to enable young people to achieve sustainable, paid employment by equipping them with the skills they need for work through learning in the workplace.

This means that you will primarily learn on-the-job but will typically have one study day in the Catch22 Kent offices to develop your academic and vocational skills. Students complete a personalised study programme which includes the chance to study for relevant qualifications, if suitable, and to develop English and Maths skills to an appropriate level.

We will ensure your needs, abilities and aspirations are matched to an appropriate job and will support you with pre-work skills. We will continue this support throughout the internship, regularly communicating with your employer to ensure the match is appropriate for your progression.

HOW LONG IS THE INTERNSHIP?

Internships normally last for a year and include unpaid work placements of at least six months. Wherever possible, the employer you have been placed with will support your move into paid employment at the end of the programme..

The programme is supported by specially trained staff (Employment Support Officers and Job Coaches) to support both employees and their employers throughout the internship.

HOW DOES THIS DIFFER FROM A TRAINEESHIP OR APPRENTICESHIP?

Young people on supported internships are expected to require a higher level of support than a trainee or apprentice and will be offered workplace support in the form of a job coach, as well as support for their non-workplace learning.

A key difference to traineeships is that interns are expected to need a longer programme than a trainee, for whom the maximum programme length is six months, before they are ready to progress to an Apprenticeship or other sustainable employment.

APPLICATION CRITERIA

- Learners must be aged between 16-25
- Learners need to have an EHCP to be able to access this programme.
