

You can pay as a one-off dinner if your child only wishes to participate in this lunch. If your child is entitled to free school meals, you do not need to take any action. However, to ensure we know who is having the lunch, please return the attached slip especially if your child is normally packed lunch.

Please complete the permission slip attached indicating if your child would like a special painting on their hand, without your permission, your child will unfortunately not be able to participate in this activity.
