In Term 5 a Pupil Voice questionnaire was completed to ascertain how pupils feel about school and the curriculum offer. From 168 completed questionnaire's the results have been collated into the following results;

A large number of pupils, 145, taking part said they like attending school and are happy whilst here with comments such as;




While 23 pupils gave mixed answers including "No", "Sometimes" and "Yes and No".

The activities that pupils prefer doing from the 168 results include;



Their favourite lessons in order of preference are;



Pupils identified themselves being good at various things including;



Pupils identified that they find most difficulty with;

Lessons with hard work including subjects such as Physical Education, Maths and Reading

Social development and relationships such as making friends, staying friends and listening to adults.

The majority of pupils identified that adults can help them with things they find difficult with some identifying that their friends can also do this. Some also identified:

“Going to the sensory garden”

were helpful.

When asked if there was anything that they didn't like doing at school they said;
