THE PARENTS / CARERS



I/We shall try to:

- see that my child attends school regularly, on time, in appropriate school uniform;
- arrange, wherever possible, all appointments at the end of the school day or during school holidays. For hospital
 appointments attend school before/after appointments wherever possible. Please provide copies of appointment
 letters;
- refrain from taking holidays during the school term. For any time required from school for holidays and family
 events i.e. weddings etc I will put the request in writing prior to the time being taken. I understand that holiday/time
 off during the school term can only be granted in exceptional circumstances;
- support my child in homework and other opportunities for home learning;
- attend parents' evenings, Person Centred Review appointments and discussions about my child's progress;
- If I contact school staff via email or telephone, I will not expect a response outside of directed time, 9:00am 4:30pm Monday to Friday, I will respect school staff's personal time and privacy.
- make every effort to support my child at special events and at times of celebration of achievement;
- support the school's policies and expectations;
- encourage my child to participate in school planned learning activities within the local community;
- let the school know about any concerns or circumstances that might affect my child's work or behaviour;
- refrain from publicly discussing any issues I may have with the school on social media, including naming the school or any of its staff.
