**Re: Covid Update**

You will be aware from the letter sent home on 4/11/21 that there is currently an outbreak of COVID-19 at Meadowfield School.

The Leadership Team are in close communication with Governors, the UK Health Security Agency (*formerly Public Health England*), KCC and our Area Education Officer. We are continually reviewing our Covid risk assessments and we have a wealth of Covid secure measures in place. - Wearing a mask when on school grounds including the car park (*as stated in the letters, App messages and emails dated 1/11/21 and 4/11/21, as well as the sizable banner in the car park*).
- If you are exempt from wearing a face mask, please ensure you are wearing your exemption lanyard and that you practice social distancing. From 9/11/21, if you are not wearing a mask you will be asked to leave the premises.
- Ensuring that household members that are aged 11 and over continue to test twice weekly.

Special events, trips and visitors have been cancelled through to 19<sup>th</sup> November. Next week we shall re-evaluate to see if cancellations need to be extended to until the Christmas break.
