Dear Parents and Carers

Update Information Letter

I hope everyone is keeping warm considering the current sub-zero temperatures.

I have been keeping an eye on the weather and also the travel conditions. There continues to be an amber alert for severe cold weather as well as a met office yellow warning for snow. I understand that many major roads have been gritted but that side roads have not been treated and continue to be very icy and treacherous.

Our Site Team cleared and gritted the pathways and car park today but they still remained very icy and following the heavy snowfall late morning and during the afternoon, the car park and pathways remain extremely slippery with snow and ice. Although the Site Team have spread salt grit with the freezing conditions and new snowfall this has not provided us with a safe environment for school and parent transport.

I have also been consulting with the Assistant Principals regarding staffing capacity for tomorrow. As you know, due to Covid, we have limited staffing and we are unable to deploy staff as flexibly we would normally do because of the bubble system. We know that it is highly likely that several members of staff who live in neighbouring villages would not be able to travel into school tomorrow due to the severe weather conditions.

Taking these factors into consideration, Meadowfield School will be closed on Thursday, 11th February.

Hopefully we will be able to reopen on Friday, for those pupils who are on the rota to attend school on a Friday. I will continue to carefully monitor the situation.

We will be providing learning through our remote home learning systems and Teachers continue to be committed to ensuring home learning is as good as it can be.
